1. Call to Order

Mayor Wes Mays called the meeting to order, determined that a quorum was present and convened into the Executive Session at 8:00 a.m.

2. Executive Session (Closed to the Public)

City Council discussed the following items:

- Direction was provided for staff to continue researching the development of an overlay district for Old Town Coppell.**
- Direction was provided for staff to continue design of digital signage in Old Town for both the median signage and the proposed partnership with the Old Town Property Owners Association as presented.**
- Continued conversation around the vision for Old Town including the geographical boundaries and investment possibilities to grow a variety of events and business options.**
- Definition of "success" in Old Town.**
- The level of investment warranted in Old Town, how to track return on the investments, and how to balance continued support of other businesses not located in Old Town.**

Staff will report back with the following:

- Regarding the overlay district, staff will provide information regarding passage rates of the similar overlay districts.**
- Regarding digital signage, staff will provide additional information and imagery for vertical signage in Old Town.**

6. Discussion regarding One Coppell.
