Introduction:

Presentation of the Texas Municipal Library Directors Association “Achievement of Excellence in Libraries Award” to the William T. Cozby Public Library.

Analysis:

The library has received the Texas Municipal Library Directors Association “Achievement of Excellence in Libraries Award” for the eighth consecutive year. Libraries are selected for this honor based on specific criteria in each of ten categories including enhanced services, literacy support, collaborative efforts and programs. The award recognizes libraries that have succeeded in providing a wide range of library services to their service population. The William T. Cozby Public Library is one of 30 out of over 500 libraries across the state to receive the award.
