**Reference:** Discussion regarding Street Maintenance Sales Tax election.

**Introduction:** A discussion will be provided on the upcoming re-authorization of the Sales and Use Tax for Street Maintenance scheduled for the November 5<sup>th</sup> General Election. The ordering of the election is scheduled to come before the City Council on the July 23<sup>rd</sup> agenda.

**Analysis:** Past elections have greatly shown the support of the Coppell residents for street infrastructure maintenance. In 2007, 63% of the Coppell voters initially voted in favor of the adoption of the Sales and Use Tax for Street Maintenance. In 2011, 72% of the voters re-authorized the continued collection, and in 2015, 83% of the Coppell voters supported the continued collection.

The last day to order the election is August 19, 2019. The last day to register to vote is October 7, 2019. Early voting will be held October 21-November 1, 2019. Election Day is November 5, 2019.
