1. Call To Order

Chair Singh called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

2. Citizens' Appearance

Chair Singh advised that no one signed up to speak.

3. Approval of Minutes: May 14, 2026

A motion was made by Boardmember Radhakrishnan, seconded by Boardmember Diamond, that this agenda item be approved. The motion was carried by a unanimous vote.

4. Board Member Roles and Responsibilities Discussion

Vice Chair Phillips presented to the board the idea of forming teams to provide targeted support to the library. Board members were asked to evaluate potential roles and responsibilities that aligned with their individual skills, expertise, and interests, as well as identify ways they could contribute to advancing the library's goals. Members discussed examples of possible teams, including advocacy and community engagement, strategic planning, fundraising and partnerships, policy review, and programming support. The board expressed interest in further exploring the concept and defining the purpose and expectations of each board member.

5. Strategic Plan Overview and Discussion

The board received an overview of the draft Library Strategic Plan and discussed its key goals and priorities. Board members shared ideas on how they could support library staff in achieving the plan's objectives, including leveraging their individual expertise, serving as advocates within the community, and participating in focused initiatives aligned with the strategic goals. The discussion emphasized collaboration between the board and library staff to help advance the library's long-term vision.
