Please accept this letter as my desire to appeal the decision of the Planning and Zoning Commission to City Council and be present for the scheduled March 24, 2020 meeting.

As I spoke of earlier, I have had a tremendous family interruption and having been recently granted emergency custody of my son due to his abuse, I have been somewhat hyperfocused, completely and entirely on his needs and this has led to letting everything else drop. Thursday, February 20, I was entailed in meetings all day long with Child Protective Services, Trauma Psychologist, and Attorneys with respect to the safety and well-being of my son.

Under such duress, I have shelved everything. I just want to make you aware that significant life interruption for me has occurred. I did not miss the meeting because I didn't feel it to be important, and intend to be present at the City Council meeting as scheduled.
