Recap from previous discussions:

<u>July 24, 2018</u> – Initially presented two options for recording work sessions – one mounted and one portable.

• Council asked for more information regarding a mounted solution.

January 22, 2019 – Presented a quote for the equipment which would include: two HD cameras, mounts and microphones for the 1st and 2nd Floor Conference Rooms.

- Proposed cost: approximately \$20,000 + cost of AV Technician at \$125/hour for four hour increments.
- Council requested a listing of cities recording work sessions and a demonstration.
