Manager's Report

- -Updates to our agenda and calendar have been made in collaboration with the city secretary. It is important that we are in alignment with the other boards and commissions. We will have a quarterly report from the Friends of the Library, Youth Advisors, and Manager. Most other business will require a request to ensure we are discussing relevant, urgent business.
- -Library staff is currently working on budget requests for FY2026. We are looking to keep our budget relatively flat, and we take pride in ensuring we are fiscally responsible.
- -We will also be replacing some of the shelving in the children's section. We are working with our vendor to replace our "most loved" shelves.
- -All library staff will be attending the Texas Library Association (TLA) conference on Wednesday, April 2. The library will be closed, but we will come back with lots of inspiration for future programming and growth opportunities.
- -On June 1, 2025, the library will be changing its hours to accommodate earlier story time programming. Please see the comparison below:
