

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COPPELL, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING CHAPTER 2, "BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS", BY REPEALING AND REPLACING ARTICLE 2-1, "LIBRARY BOARD", SECTION 2-1-4 (C), "MEETINGS", AND SECTION 2-1-5 (C-H), "POWERS AND DUTIES", FOR THE COZBY LIBRARY AND COMMUNITY COMMONS BOARD; AND, PROVIDING A SEVERVABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; AND, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coppel, Texas (the "City"), has investigated and determined that Chapter 2, "Boards and Commissions", should be amended by repealing and replacing Article 2-1, "Library Board", Section 2-1-4 (C), "Meetings", and Section 2-1-5 (C-H), "Powers and Duties" in its entirety for the Cozby Library and Community Commons Board; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is necessary to repeal the current provisions for the administration of the boards of the City of Coppel as provided herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COPPELL, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Coppel, Texas, be and the same is hereby amended by amending Chapter 2, "Boards and Commissions", by repealing and replacing Article 2-1, "Library Board", Section 2-1-4 (C), "Meetings", and Section 2-1-5 (C-H), "Powers and Duties", in its entirety to establish policies for lawful organization for the Cozby Library and Community Commons Board, which shall read as follows:

" CHAPTER 2- BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

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ARTICLE 2-1. LIBRARY BOARD

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Sec. 2-1-1. Creation

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C. All meetings require a quorum of five voting members. A voting member is defined as a regular member who has been appointed by council or alternate member who is substituting for a regular member.

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Sec. 2-1-5. Powers and Duties.

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C. Act in an advisory capacity to the city council, concerning policies pertaining to the Cozby Library.

D. Promote Cozby Library to the community and cooperate with other governmental agencies and civic groups in the advancement of the library.

E. Review and/or recommendation to the Council regarding improvements to govern library.

F. Assist in promoting policies and functions of the library to the public.

G. May act as a board of appeals for library patrons regarding material reconsideration or challenge. Assist in long-range planning and give input for improvement and expansion of library services and facilities, and review and make recommendations to the city council regarding the library's master and five-year plans.

H. Unless deferred, provide annual library board reports to the city council regarding its goals and objectives and its input for future library services.

Sec. 2-1-6. Reserved.

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SECTION 2. That should any word, phrase, paragraph, section or portion of this ordinance or of the Code of Ordinances, as amended hereby, be held to be void or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of said ordinance or of the Code of Ordinances, as amended hereby, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That all provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Coppell, Texas, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby, repealed, and all other provisions not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That this chapter as adopted shall be in full force and effective from and after the date upon final acceptance
