### General Information:

- Contract with Dallas County Health and Human Services for Health Services.
- The County will provide our residents the following health services: Tuberculosis Control Services; Sexually Transmitted Disease Control Services; Communicable Disease Control Services, and Laboratory Services.
- The County will provide our residents the following health services, Immunizations; Child health care; High- risk infant case management; and Home visits.

### Introduction:

This agenda item is for the renewal of an Interlocal Agreement for coordinated Health Services between the City of Coppell and Dallas County Health and Human Services.

The County agrees to operate the Program, which will include the following Health Services: Tuberculosis Control Services; Sexually Transmitted Disease Control Services; Communicable Disease Control Services; and Laboratory Services.

The County also agrees to provide to the City, in accordance with state and federal law, the following public health services: Immunizations; Child health care; high risk infant case management; and home visits.

The County uses “a sliding-scale fee” based on the residents’ ability to pay for these services, and the City pays \$3,131,00 per year, which is the agreed-upon amount for the City’s share of the total cost of the Program less federal and state funding.

**Analysis:**

This agreement has been in existence for over 25 years, and the city is billed by the County monthly. The billing amount has remained the same for over 15 years.
