Reference: Consider approval of an Interlocal Agreement, with the City of Grapevine, for detention services; and authorizing the Mayor to sign.

2040: Sustainable Government

Introduction:

The City of Coppel Police Department is asking for approval from City Council to enter an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Grapevine for continued use of their city jail. The Interlocal Agreement is for three years at a flat fee cost of \$124,085.50. Future rates will be based on a three-year rolling annual average of persons booked into the Grapevine Jail by Coppel PD. The agreed upon rate is currently \$284.60 per prisoner.

Background:

The City of Coppel Police Department entered an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Grapevine for use of their jail services. The original interlocal agreement went into effect October 1, 2022 for a term of one year with two one-year extensions, which the City exercised in FY24 and FY 25. The final extension will expire on September 30, 2025.

Legal Review:

The Interlocal Agreement was reviewed by Bob Hager.

Fiscal Impact:

The \$124,085.50 will be funded by the Crime Control Fund. This amount is within the annual budgeted jail costs in the Crime Control Fund.

Recommendation:

The Coppel Police Department is recommending approval of this agenda item.
