Assumptions, Clarifications, & Exclusions

Schedule

• Anticipated Start: Upon Receipt of PO and materials are received

• Long Lead Items: 8 weeks for basketball hoops

• Projected Duration: 3 weeks

Contingency & Allowances

• Change Management – Based on direction from the Owner, CORE has not included contingencies and/or allowances. Any unforeseen conditions, schedule impacts (outside of contractor control), scope changes, escalation, acceleration, overtime, premium time, etc. will result in Owner Change Orders. In addition, the time necessary to price and confirm formal authorization to proceed could have an impact on the overall construction schedule. Including contingencies and or allowances in the base contract allow the Project Team to avoid these items within the originally defined schedule and established contract amount.

General Assumptions

- This cost proposal is considered a Lump Sum, not line-item Estimate.
- Unless otherwise included in scope below, CORE has not included any costs for permits, including but not limited to: building permit, systems permit, or dust control.

Product Description

Basketball Backstop shall be the 5065XY Outdoor Backstop by Draper, Inc. Spiceland, IN.

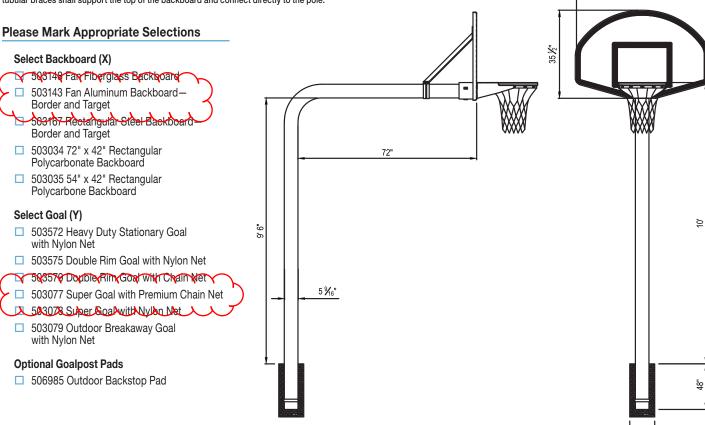
5065XY Backstop shall have a $5^9/_{16}$ " OD heavy-wall galvanized post with an approximate 24" radius to extend the face of the backboard 6'0" from the front edge of the post. The backboard and goal bolt directly to the post nose plate forming a solid unit that transfers loads to the heavy-duty steel post to eliminate strain on the backboard.

XY indicates the backboard and goal. Backstop available with a variety of backboards and goals per charts below and posts have a hot dipped galvanized finish. Design shall be a bent gooseneck style and allow for a 48" bury into the ground and a 72" extension from the front of the pole to the face of the backboard. Two 1 5/s "diameter, 13 ga. flow coated galvanized tubular braces shall support the top of the backboard and connect directly to the pole.

Pole shall be designed so that the rim mounts directly to the nose plate attached to the horizontal pole section through the backboard to eliminate stress on the backboard during play. Pole systems without backboard support braces shall not be considered equal.

See appropriate submittal documents for selected backboard and goal.

Installation to be completed in accordance with manufacturer's instructions. Do not scale drawings. Entire system shall weigh 360#.

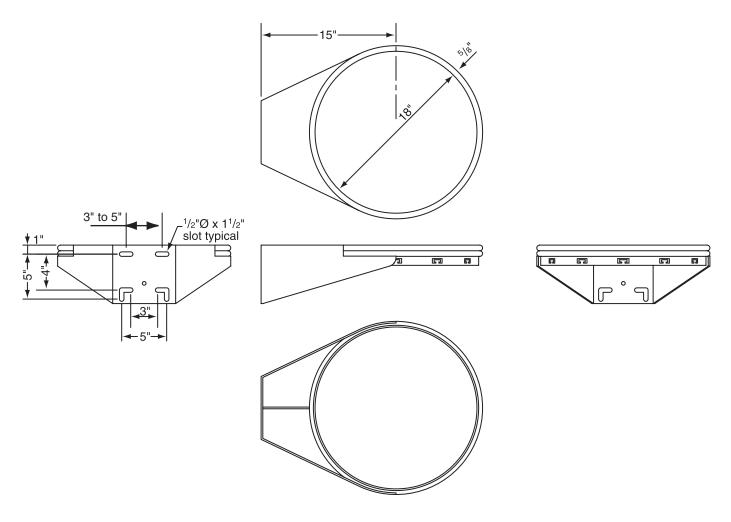

Product Description

Goal shall consist of two 5/8" diameter high strength steel rings welded together at a minimum of six places. Back, side and center gusset plates shall be 3/16" thick and be continuously welded. The net attachment system shall be of a continuous type constructed of 3/16" x 1" steel with punched net attachment slots suitable for nylon or chain nets. Rim shall be punched to mount on any front mount backboard and shall have an orange powder coated finish. Grade 5 mounting hardware shall be included.

Goal provided with Premium Steel Net. Net shall be constructed entirely of welded link smooth chain. Chain wire diameter shall be no less than .133". Net assembly shall include no more than two non-welded links and result in rectangular net openings that reduce the risk of hand or finger entrapment. Net shall attach to the rim by means of twelve S-hooks that are no less that .188" diameter. Net and S-hooks shall be zinc plated.

Goal shall weigh approximately 30 lbs. and is covered an Unconditional Lifetime Warranty. Premium Steel Chain Net covered by 2-year limited warranty.

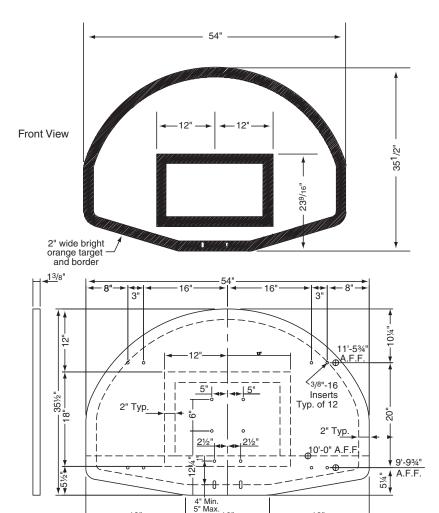
Backboard shall be cast with structural reinforcing ribs on backside with a heavy, 13/8" deep perimeter flange to provide maximum strength. Back side of bank shall be furnished with twelve (12) tapped holes (3/8"-16) to fit standard mounting attachment without exposed bolt heads on face of backboard.

Backboard shall be finished with a special white, non-glare enamel, with orange perimeter and target area competition striping.

Backboard shall be drilled for a front mount type goal (5" horizontal x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " vertical).
