# **Previous Meeting Suggestions**

- 1. Neel asked at the previous meeting if we could add book recommendation software to our catalogue. We do already have software called "Novelist" that has this functionality in our catalogue.
- 2. Request for a Digital Services Presentation: We will plan this for the fall, most likely split into two sessions, one in November and one in December. This will allow our staff to focus on both the databases and other digital resources available in the library.
