Reference: Consider approval for the purchase of streetlight poles from JB Electric; for the Royal Lane Reconstruction project for Roadway Illumination; in the amount of \$177,137.00; as provided by the Series 2024 Certificate of Obligation Bonds; and authorizing the City Manager to sign any necessary documents.

Introduction:

The purpose of this agenda item is to consider approval for the additional purchase of streetlight poles for the Royal Lane Reconstruction project for Roadway Illumination from JB Electric in the amount of \$177,137.00; as provided by bond funds; and authorizing the City Manager to sign.

Background:

On January 28, 2020 the City opened seven bids for streetlight poles and fixtures. The bidders were not required to bid on both Street Light Poles and LED Fixtures but only the portions they chose. JB Electric Lighting and Design was the lowest bidder for streetlight poles and the City had been purchasing the Street Light Poles from JB Electric for the previous five years. This contract has a one-year extension that was exercised in January 2026. At the conclusion of the extension period, the City will go out for new bids for streetlight poles and fixtures.

This purchase will be for 51 streetlight poles for the Royal Lane medians. The lead time for poles is an estimated 10-12 weeks. The fixtures will be purchased as a standalone contract at a later date with a lead time of only 4-6 weeks.

Benefit to the Community:

This project will improve the infrastructure on one of our major thoroughfares.

Legal Review:

The Purchasing Department has reviewed the documents and determined that this is an appropriate method of contracting with these vendors. Standard purchasing documents are being utilized.

Fiscal Impact:

The fiscal impact of this agenda item is \$177,137.00 as provided by the Series 2024 Certificate of Obligation bonds.

Recommendation:

The Public Works Department recommends approval of this item.
