A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COPPELL, TEXAS, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 010996.3, THE MASTER FEE SCHEDULE, AS AMENDED, BY AMENDING THE COPPELL CITY CODE FEES (BUILDING), IN PART; FIRE PREVENTION FEES, IN PART; EMERGENCY AMBULANCE FEES, IN PART; AND RECREATIONAL FEES, IN PART; AND PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Coppel, Texas, previously adopted Resolution No. 010996.3 to provide for general and special fees and charges to be assessed and collected by the City, as authorized by the Code of Ordinances and other applicable codes, ordinances, resolutions, and laws; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Coppel desires to amend certain fees as set forth therein and delete others as authorized by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COPPELL, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Master Fee Schedule section entitled “Chapter 15, Coppel City Code (Building)” be amended, in part to read as follows:

SECTION 2. That the Master Fee Schedule section entitled “Chapter 15-5-1, Fire Prevention Fees” be amended, in part to read as follows:

Fire Sprinkler System Plan Review and Inspection

\$100.00 + \$1.00 per head for 1st 250
\$350.00 + \$0.50 per head – 251-500
\$600.00 + \$.025 per head – 501 and over

Fire Alarm System Plan Review and Inspection

\$50.00 + \$1.00 per device (notification and initiating) for 1st 100
\$150.00 + \$0.50 per device (notification and initiating) – 101-200
\$250.00 + \$0.25 per device (notification and initiating) - 201 and over

Fire Prevention Re-Inspection

\$75.00 per hour (min 1 hour)

Tent Permit – over 400 sf	\$50.00
Fire Suppression System Plan Review and Inspection	\$100.00
Egress Control Plan Review and Inspection	\$50.00 + \$15.00 per door

SECTION 3. That the Master Fee Schedule section entitled “Chapter 15-5-6, “Emergency Ambulance Service” be amended, in part to read as follows:

Advanced Life Support	\$1,600.00
Advanced Life Support – 2	\$1,750.00
Basic Life Support	\$1,400.00
Advanced Life Support Disposable	\$400.00
Basic Life Support Disposable	\$350.00
Oxygen	\$125.00
TNT	\$125.00
Ground Mileage	\$24.00 per mile

SECTION 4. That the Master Fee Schedule section entitled “Recreational Fees” be amended, in part to read as follows:

SECTION 5. That all provisions of the resolutions of the City of Coppell, Texas, in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution, except as noted herein, be, and the same are hereby, repealed, and all other provisions not in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. That should any word, phrase, paragraph, or section of this Resolution be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Resolution as a whole, or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, and shall not affect the validity of the Resolution as a whole.

SECTION 7. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage as the law and charter in such cases provide.
