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### **Introduction:**

This agenda item is being presented for approval to establish a no parking ordinance for a portion of the Enclaves Court as requested by the “Enclaves On The Parkway” Home Owners Association (HOA).

### **Analysis:**

When cars park on both (east and west) sides of Enclaves Ct. at the intersection with Parkway Blvd., access is inhibited to the neighborhood, especially for emergency response vehicles. As a cul-de-sac, this is the only ingress/egress for the neighborhood. This request has been discussed/approved by the HOA members.

### **Legal Review:**

### **Fiscal Impact:**

The cost to install one (1) no parking sign is approximately \$110.

### **Recommendation:**

The Engineering Department recommends the approval of the no parking ordinance.
