### Introduction:

The purpose of this agenda item is to approve an addendum to a contract with Illumination Fireworks, LP to add additional fireworks and effects to the Celebrate Coppel 2026 show, for a total contract amount of \$59,999.00.

### Background:

Since 2022, Community Experiences has worked with Illumination Fireworks to provide the fireworks show at Celebrate Coppel: Party in the Park.

In an effort to consistently provide excellent community special events that residents of Coppel enjoy, and in celebration of America’s 250<sup>th</sup> birthday in 2026, the Community Experiences department would like to expand the Celebrate Coppel: Party in the Park fireworks show. The expanded show will include:

1. Two additional minutes of programming, increasing the total show length to 20 minutes
2. Premium specialty shells that create unique visual effects throughout the performance
3. An upgraded grand finale featuring denser sequencing, layered effects, and a higher impact conclusion

**Benefit to the Community:**

Exceptional special events are integral to the experience residents enjoy as part of living in Coppell. This contract will assist staff in providing a unique and high-quality fireworks show to the community to help celebrate America's 250<sup>th</sup> birthday.
