Samaritan's Purse Fellowship Addition, Replat, Lots 1R and 2, Block A

LOCATION: NWQ Creekview Drive and West Bethel Road

SIZE OF AREA: 27.557 acres of property

CURRENT ZONING: PD-296R-LI

REQUEST: To create two lots which includes extending Lot 1 south of the existing Planned Development to be used for additional parking and Lot 2 will consist of the existing gas well site and the remainder of the existing tract.

HISTORY: All of the property was once owned by Fellowship Church. A portion was sold to Samaritan's purse and developed as their office warehouse. A portion of the adjacent tract is a gas well that will remain.

HISTORIC COMMENT: The property has no known historical significance.

TRANSPORTATION: Creekview Drive is two lane road within a 60-ft right-of-way.

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN: The *Amended Coppel 2030 Comprehensive Master Plan* shows this property as Industrial Special District.

DISCUSSION:

This plat request is a companion item to the Lot 1R, Block A, Samaritan's Purse Planned Development zoning case. The plat will replat the existing lot to include the fire lanes for the site plan for the 14,480-sf commercial building and extend south to incorporate additional parking and a separate lot for the gas well.
