Review of Accomplishments/Activities from October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023:

The following projects were funded:

- Andrew Brown West Bridge Deck Replacement
- Replacement of the Outdoor Warning System (Perryweather)
- Site renovations at The Duck Pond Park
- Site renovations at Thweatt Park
- Playground resurfacing at Allen Road Park
- Replacement of furniture at The CORE
- Replacement of weight machines at The CORE
- Replacement of outdoor pool plaster at The CORE
- Replacement of outdoor slide tower at The CORE
- Design agreement for Veteran's Memorial project

Also, the following activities were completed:

- Produced and approved a Budget and Annual Work Program for FY 2023-24
- Facilitated a Public Hearing regarding the proposed 2023-24 Work Program

Proposed Activities for 2023-2024:

- Replacement of indoor pool lighting at The CORE (from 2022-2023 Work Program)
- Execute the 2023-2024 Work Program:
 - o Repair and/or replacement of park amenities including playgrounds, picnic tables, trash receptacles, fencing and furnishings
 - o Replacement of artificial turf at Coppell Middle School North
 - o Replacement of North Levee Trail Bridge wood decking
 - o Repainting of amenities in the parks
 - o Replacement of spectator shade at Wagon Wheel Park
 - o Replacement of dugout shade at Wagon Wheel Park
 - o Installation of fencing at Wagon Wheel soccer fields
 - o Reconstruction of Waggin' Tails Dog Park
 - o Design and construction of a Veteran's Memorial
 - o Operations and maintenance of the Coppell Arts Center
