Reference: Consider approval of an award to EliteTrax Sports Surfaces for the repair, resurfacing, and renovation of pickleball courts 5-12 at Wagon Wheel Tennis & Pickleball Center; in the amount of \$94,220.00; as provided for in the Coppel Recreation and Development (CRDC) fund, and authorizing the City Manager to sign any necessary documents.

2040: Sustainable City Government: Excellent and Well-Maintained City Infrastructure and Facilities

Introduction:

The purpose of this agenda item is to consider approval of an award to EliteTrax Sports Surfaces for the repair, resurfacing, and renovation of pickleball courts 5-12 at Wagon Wheel Tennis & Pickleball Center in the amount of \$94,220.00, as provided for in the CRDC fund.

Background:

The Wagon Wheel Tennis & Pickleball Center is comprised of 7 dedicated tennis courts, 12 dedicated pickleball courts, and 3 tennis courts that have hybrid lines making an additional 6 pickleball courts. In December 2024 an annual resurfacing project was completed to transform 2 tennis courts into 8 dedicated pickleball courts (now courts 5-12). These courts are utilized for all pickleball activities including open play, classes, programs, leagues, and reservations. Since completion of that project, the courts have seen major cracking and delamination and need immediate attention to prevent further damage and ensure safe play.

The current damages on the courts have created safety concerns resulting in one of the courts no longer being playable, and others having serious issues that affect the quality of play on the courts.

Staff solicited and reviewed proposals from three qualified vendors across the DFW metroplex capable of meeting the scope of work. Following a thorough evaluation, EliteTrax Sports Surfaces was selected based on their proven track record, outstanding professional references, and

demonstrated commitment to quality. Their history of consistent execution, attention to detail, and reliable performance on similar projects gives staff high confidence in their ability to deliver exceptional results safely, on time, and within budget.

Benefit to the Community:

The repair and additions to the courts will allow for Wagon Wheel Tennis and Pickleball Center to fully utilize these courts again in a way that lives up to the standards of Coppell. In addition, it will allow for a more optimal layout of the courts within USA Pickleball guidelines, ensuring safe play, and a better-quality experience for all users.

Legal Review:

This item does not require legal review.

Fiscal Impact:

The fiscal impact of this agenda item is \$94,220.00, as provided for in the Coppell Recreation Development Corporation (CRDC) fund balance. This item went through the CRDC public hearing process that concluded on July 20th, 2026, at the CRDC meeting.
