Board and moving the alternate member, Brian Olsen, into the role of regular member

for the remainder of the unexpired term.

2030: Sense of Community: Residents and Businesses Engaged and Contributing to the

Introduction:

On May 6, 2019 Boardmember Earl Nesbitt submitted his resignation from the Parks and Recreation Board, which leaves one unexpired term for a voting member and potentially one unexpired term for the alternate positions.

Analysis:

Earl Nesbitt was re-appointed in December 2018 to serve a two-year term as a voting member on the Parks and Recreation Board. Due to Mr. Nesbitt relocating to Dallas, he has resigned from the board. Brian Olsen was appointed to a two-year term for an alternate position in December 2018. The Parks and Recreation Department recommends moving Brian Olsen to the regular position to replace Earl Nesbitt. There has not been a recommendation to replace the alternate position that would result if Mr. Olsen is moved to the regular position.

Legal Review:

Legal review is not required.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no fiscal impact.

Recommendation:

Parks and Recreation Department recommends acceptance of Mr. Nesbitt's resignation and the appointment of Brian Olsen to fulfill the vacated two-year term.
