

POINT IN TIME HOMELESS RESULTS JANUARY 2019

Metrocrest Services spearheaded the effort to count the unsheltered homeless in Carrollton, Farmers Branch, Addison, Coppell, and a portion of Dallas (in Denton County).

This count had never occurred for our community in the past. Amazing volunteers trekked out on the cold evening of January 24 from 8:00 p.m.-11:00 p.m. to locate individuals who were homeless. Homelessness is defined by Housing and Urban Development (HUD) as living outdoors or in a place not intended for human habitation, such as a car.

Total Volunteers=63 Volunteer Hours=249

In addition to the unsheltered count reported to HUD, Metrocrest Services felt it critical to also identify others in our community who, while not homeless from a HUD perspective, were housing unstable. This included school district students who were living in motels, doubling up with family or friends, or living in a shelter. We also attempted to identify how many of our residents lived in our motels.
