Veterans Memorial Project – We have received final plans and are currently preparing bid documents.

Staff kicked off this project with a tour of several inclusive playgrounds around the Metroplex. We are currently working on a public engagement plan regarding how we will gather input from the community around specific design elements. We will have more information soon.
