Reference: Consider approval to award contract with Consolidated Traffic Controls, Inc.; utilizing HGAC Contract No. PE-05-21; to purchase and install flashing yellow arrows at various intersections, in the amount of \$103,680.00 as budgeted in Traffic Infrastructure Maintenance Fund; and authorizing the city manager to sign necessary documents.

Introduction:

The purpose of this agenda item is to request approval of a contract with Consolidated Traffic Controls, Inc. (utilizing HGAC Contract No. PE-05-21) to purchase and install flashing yellow arrows at various intersections, in the amount of \$103,680.00 as budgeted in Infrastructure Maintenance Fund.

Background:

Flashing yellow arrows (FYA) at traffic signals are used to improve safety and traffic flow when drivers are making left turns at intersections. In 2021 the City entered into an Agreement with Dallas County for Major Capital Improvement Program (MCIP) Projects. Coppell submitted and received approval for County funding on Flashing Yellow Arrow Signal Improvements on the Denton Tap and Sandy Lake corridors with a reimbursement of 50% up to \$88,000. Some of these improvements have been completed through funding of other projects on traffic signals on these major corridors. This project will complete the FYA improvements for the remainder of these corridors. This item is a companion item to the Dallas County Project Specific Agreement. Dallas County will reimburse us 50% totaling \$51,840.00.

This item was procured through the Houston-Galveston Area Council purchasing cooperative.

Benefit to the Community:

To provide Sustainable Government, this project will improve the traffic flow and safety through the Denton Tap and Sandy Lake Corridors.

Legal Review:

The City's standard construction contracts are periodically reviewed by the City Attorney.

Fiscal Impact:

The fiscal impact of this agenda item is \$103,680.00 as budgeted from the Traffic Infrastructure Maintenance Fund.

Recommendation:

The Public Works Department recommends approval of this contract.
