<b>Reference:</b>	Consider approval of the property tax revenue increase
2030:	Sustainable City Government

## **Introduction:**

Pursuant to Section 102.007 (c) of the Texas Local Government Code, when a budget raises more revenue from property tax than in the previous year, a separate vote of the governing body is required to ratify this increase. A vote under this section is in addition to and separate from the vote to adopt the budget or a vote to set the tax rate.

# Analysis:

This separate agenda item requirement is based on the fact the Fiscal Year 2019-20 Annual Operating Budget will raise more revenue from property taxes than last year's budget.

# Legal Review:

This agenda item was reviewed during the Council packet process.

## **Fiscal Impact:**

The property tax revenue increase is \$3,500,836, which is an 8.05% increase from last year's budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$2,027,528.

## **Recommendation:**

The Finance Department recommends approval.
