
Crime Prevention District Special Revenue

The Crime Prevention District special revenue fund is restricted to crime prevention programs and services. Revenues come primarily from the ¼ cents sales tax, which are expected to decrease due to changes at the State level. Expenditures in FY2025 include the School Resource Officer program, jail services, and the joint emergency dispatch center.
