Project Update

The Duck Pond Park – Bids have closed. We will bring this project to City Council for award on April 11 and then to CRDC for award on April 17.

Thweatt Park – The CRDC Board has approved this project. Construction will begin soon and should last about 7 months.

Magnolia Park Trail – We have received a timeline of June 30 for all surveys to be complete and to receive 100% design plans. Once plans are received, we will put the project out to bid asap.

Moore Road Boardwalk – Currently under construction. We expect to complete this project in September, weather permitting.

Dog Park Renovation – This project is currently in design.

General Updates for the Board

Cricket Ribbon Cutting – The ribbon cutting ceremony for the new cricket field located by Wagon Wheel Field 6 is Tuesday, April 4th at 11AM. All are welcome to attend.

Landscaped Medians – During the "2023 Projects and Initiatives" presentation at February's Board meeting, staff mentioned that City medians were being studied to see if there was an alternate design that could reduce water usage.
