- LANDSCAPE NOTES:

 1. Plant material shall be measured and sized according to the latest edition of the Texas Association of Nursery (TAN) Standards.

 2. Topsoil shall be a minimum of 5 inches in depth in planting areas. Soil shall be free of stones, roots, clods and any foreign material that is not beneficial for plant growth.

 3. All plant beds shall be top-dressed with a minimum of 3 inches of hardwood or other mulch.

 4. Trees shall be planted at least 4 feet from any utility line, curb, walk, and fire connection and outside all utility assements.

 5. Tree overhanging walks and parking shall have a minimum clear trunk height of 7 feet. Trees overhanging public street pavement drive aisles and fire lanes shall have a minimum clear trunk height of 14 feet.

 A visibility trangle must be provided at all interesting.

 A visibility thraigle must be provided at all intersections. Shrubs are not to exceed 30 inches in height. Trees shall have a minimum clear trunk height of 8 feet.

 Trees planted on a slope shall have the soil stain at the average grade of slope.

 No shrubs shall be permitted within areas less than 3 feet in with. All beds less than 3 feet in with what he grass, groundcover, or some type of fixed paving.

 15. No planting area shall sexceed 3:1 slope 3' horizontal to 1' vertical.


