### **Introduction:**

As part of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, the City of Coppel is set to receive a total allocation of \$10.2 million. At the September 14, 2021 Work Session, staff presented information regarding the guidelines for eligible uses of ARPA funds and discussed preliminary projects that meet the eligibility criteria. On December 14, 2021, the Council identified the priority projects to fund with ARP dollars. Subsequently, staff has been conducting due diligence and moving forward on those projects.

This agenda item is a two-part follow-up to that discussion to further refine the direction regarding the way ARPA funds are expended. Staff has adjusted the list of projects to provide additional flexibility for funds and projects. Additionally, Mindi Hurley, Director of Community Development, will be providing an update on the business support programs that are identified in this ARP matrix.

Staff will be seeking direction from the Council regarding allocation of the undesignated ARP funds.
