WHEREAS, A woman in the U.S. today has a 1 in 8 chance of developing breast cancer over her lifetime and a 1 in 39 chance of dying from breast cancer; and

WHEREAS, Nearly 30% of women diagnosed with early-stage breast cancer later develop metastatic breast cancer; and

WHEREAS, U.S. men make up 1 of every 100 breast cancer diagnoses in the country; and

WHEREAS, Increased awareness, especially of family history and other common risk factors, preventive care, and regular screenings, including mammograms, can help save lives through early diagnosis and prompt treatment; and

WHEREAS, Through early detection and improved treatments, there are about 4 million breast cancer survivors in the U.S., including women receiving breast cancer treatment.

"National Breast Cancer Awareness Month"
