### **Introduction:**

As part of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, the City of Coppel is set to receive a total allocation of \$10.2 million. In August 2021, the City received the first allocation of \$5,131,770.90. A second allocation is scheduled to be disbursed to the City in one year in the amount of \$5,131,770.89. At the September 14, 2021 Work Session, staff presented information regarding the guidelines for eligible uses of ARPA funds and discussed preliminary projects that meet the eligibility criteria.

This agenda item is a follow-up to that discussion to further refine the direction regarding the way ARPA funds are expended. The Council will be completing a prioritization matrix that will assist in focusing the discussions around those items that are deemed the highest priorities.

Staff will be present to discuss the matrix and timeline for the next steps.
