Introduction:

The fees charged by the City have been reviewed and the proposed changes are being brought forward for Council's approval.

Analysis:

The current Solid Waste contract with Republic provides for an annual adjustment of 3.0%. For the residential customer, rates will increase from \$17.70 per month to \$18.22. The senior rate will increase from \$15.91 per month to \$16.40. The commercial rates will reflect the same 3.0% increase. This increase is effective January 1, 2022.

The fingerprinting fee of \$10.00 per card is being removed from the Master Fee Schedule. This service was provided in conjunction with jail processes. The City no longer has its own jail, so this service was discontinued. This service can be obtained from businesses throughout the metroplex.
