Introduction:

This agenda item is being presented to consider renewal of an Interlocal Government Agreement with Dallas County Health and Human Services contract for FY 14-15 for mosquito spraying. This contract is utilized to protect public health by controlling the population of mosquitoes via ground spraying.

Analysis:

The City of Coppell Environmental Health Division has an integrated Mosquito Management Program. Adulticiding is an important part of the program once positive mosquito pools and positive human cases have been identified with mosquito borne disease. This is the third year for this particular contract with Dallas County which aids the City in responding quickly to knock down the adult mosquito population in an attempt to decrease disease transmission.
