## Introduction:

Since 2010 the cities of Coppell, Addison, Carrollton, and Farmers Branch have been working cooperatively towards creating a combined public safety dispatch system. This system would allow for all four city's dispatch operations to be managed and operated within a single entity. The thought is that there would be an increased level of service for all the cities while realizing a cost savings through some economies of scale. In addition the system would be scalable to allow other municipalities to join the entity thereby enjoying even more savings to all involved.

Since that time there has been quite a bit of work and financial investment made by the four communities.
