

CODE/ORDINANCE**AMOUNT OF FEE**

- 14) As allowed by the Public Information Act, the officer for public information or the officer's agent may require a deposit or bond for payment of anticipated costs relative to creating access to and/or providing copies of public information, if the anticipated cost for providing the copy of the public information specifically requested by the requestor is in excess of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
- 15) The officer for public information or the officer's agent may not require a deposit or bond to be paid as a down payment for copies of public information that the requestor may request in the future.
- 16) The charge for providing a copy made by the municipal court clerk shall be the charge as provided by other ordinances governing Court of Record.
- 17) If any cost of inspection, processing, creating access to, or coping is not covered by this Resolution, then the public information officer shall promptly seek the opinion of the GSC in determining the appropriate fee.
