Reference: Public Hearing on the proposed 2016-17 tax rate of \$0.57950

2030: Sustainable City Government

Introduction:

Pursuant to Section 26.06 of the Texas Property Tax Code, when a proposed tax rate exceeds the notice and hearing limit, the taxing unit's governing body must hold two (2) public hearings on the proposal. At these hearings, taxpayers must have the opportunity to express their views on the proposed increase. The governing body may not adopt the tax rate at these hearings; and must announce the date and time of the meeting at which it will vote on the tax rate. The meeting to adopt the 2016 tax rate must be at least three (3) days but no more that fourteen (14) days after the public hearing.

Analysis:

As required by Local Government Code, Sec. 140.010, attached is the notice that was published in the newspaper on August 12, 2016. The 1st public hearing will be at the regular Council meeting on August 23, 2016 and the 2nd will be at a Special called meeting on August 30, 2016. The tax rate adoption is scheduled for September 13, 2016.
