**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COPPELL, TEXAS, AMENDING
RESOLUTION NO. 010996.3, THE MASTER FEE SCHEDULE, AS
AMENDED, BY AMENDING THE RECREATIONAL FEES, IN PART;
AND PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Coppel, Texas, previously adopted Resolution No. 010996.3 to provide for general and special fees and charges to be assessed and collected by the City, as authorized by the Code of Ordinances and other applicable codes, ordinances, resolutions, and laws; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Coppel desires to amend certain fees as set forth therein and delete others as authorized by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COPPELL, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Master Fee Schedule section entitled “Recreational Fees” be amended, in part to read as follows:

Recreational Fees

“ ...

4) Pavilion Rental

Fees for pavilion rentals are to be determined based upon market rates and/or customer demand with approval by the Department Director.

...”

“ ...

7) Booth Fees at Special Events

Booth fees at special events are to be determined based upon market rates and/or customer demand with approval by the Department Director.

...”

SECTION 2. That all provisions of the resolutions of the City of Coppel, Texas, in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution, except as noted herein, be, and the same are hereby, repealed, and all other provisions not in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any word, phrase, paragraph, or section of this Resolution be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Resolution as a whole, or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, and shall not affect the validity of the Resolution as a whole.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage as the law and charter in such cases provide.
