With the redevelopment of the Andy Brown Park system, expected to be completed in July 2017, the Parks and Recreation Department has an exciting opportunity to combine the City’s annual fireworks event with a “grand opening” of the new park at Andy Brown Park East. This event is anticipated to be the largest event that the City has ever held, which will serve to showcase the new park and all of its features as well as celebrate Independence Day.
