## Introduction:

Pursuant to the truth in taxation laws of Chapter 26.04 of the Texas Property Tax Code, the Tax Assessor/Collector must certify the anticipated collection rate for FY 2018-19. John R. Ames, Dallas County Tax Assess/Collection has certified the anticipated collection rate for the period of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 to be 100%.

### Analysis:

The purpose of this law is to permit a taxing unit to adjust the debt portion of its effective/rollback tax rate to account for anticipated delinquencies. The anticipated collection rate of 100% will be used in the calculation of the effective/rollback tax for 2017
