Introduction:

At the November 13, 2018 City Council Meeting, Council approved the City of Coppell's legislative agenda for the upcoming session. HB 2461 and SB 1658 relate to the territory and fees imposed by certain emergency communication districts. Specifically, this bill supports the efforts of the North Texas Emergency Communications Center (NTECC) partnership between the cities of Addison, Carrollton, Coppell and Farmers Branch. The bill is an example of the local control municipalities have today with regards to the respective decisions being made on behalf of the communities served.
