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### General Information:

- The City is responsible for maintaining conveyance in streams
- The City is responsible for maintaining storm drain infrastructure located in drainage easements
- The City needs to implement one recommended drainage improvement on Denton Creek at Denton Tap Road
- A number of intersections in the City would benefit from capacity improvements in the way of auxiliary lanes

### Introduction/Analysis:

Staff will present specific drainage projects that need to be implemented to meet obligations regarding infrastructure and conveyance maintenance. Staff will also present proposed intersection improvements at various locations in the City. Staff will request feedback on the identified projects to proceed with design and include in a future bond sale for construction.
