SUBJECT: April Director's Report

Greetings Boardmembers! The Library is getting ready to wrap up spring and roll out summer. Staff has been working hard to plan this year's summer programming, which looks to be at least as robust a season as any we've had in the past. We'll have more details for you in the coming weeks, but for now, let me just say that Coppell library users are in for quite an adventure!

In next week's meeting, we will discuss some guideline amendments that will be presented to the Board for formal consideration at the May meeting. These include changes to the room reservation guidelines as well as newly-codified guidelines for Library programs and art exhibits.

Workload Indicators

There have been no significant changes in trends observed in Library service measures. Circulation of physical collections remains slightly below previous year, but circulation of digital content, as well as measures of almost all experiential aspects of library service, continue to rise over the previous year.

Programs / Upcoming Events

The Library had a successful Spring Break, drawing almost double the number of participants in five days of TV-themed activities and programs than over seven days of Hogwarts-themed programs during Spring Break 2018.

Several Boardmembers were present at the April 9th Council meeting for the presentation of the TMLDA Excellence in Libraries Award and the proclamation of National Library Week.

Notable upcoming events include the Cultural Fair (April 27th, 12-4pm), which is being developed jointly by Library Staff and the Cultural Committee. The event will feature music, dance, crafts, and food from a variety of countries.

Shelly Brown will return for an author visit on Wednesday, April 24th, to discuss her most recent book, Squint. Her visit is sponsored by the Friends of the Coppell Public Library.

The Library will be at the Coppell Farmer's Market on Saturday, May 4th to make Star Wars crafts. (May the 4th be with you!) CozbyCon is coming up on May 11th, and preparations for the 2019 Summer Reading Programs are almost complete.

Presentation: Library Guideline Changes
