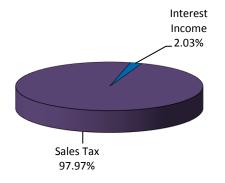
Crime Prevention District Special Revenue

The Crime Prevention District special revenue fund is restricted to crime prevention programs and services. Revenues come from the ¼-% sales tax. Expenditures in FY2020 include the School Resource Officer program, the neighboorhood/community policing program, and the joint emergency dispatch center. Increases in the services category are from increased costs for prisoner transport and care and the dispatch center. Capital replacements include the technology in the training room, fixed camera system at intersections, and the patrol fleet.
