Greetings Boardmembers, and Happy New Year! Our first meeting of the year—the decade, even—will be this Thursday, January 9th, at 7PM in the Conference Room at the Library. In addition to the usual reports, we will welcome our newest Boardmembers and Youth Advisors, and elect the Board Chair and Vice-Chair for the year 2020.

Workload Indicators

The Library's service statistics for the first quarter of FY2020 are included in your packet. Gate count and overall circulation are roughly even with previous YTD, though we are seeing an increase in new account setups and hold requests. Total program attendance for the quarter was up by 11%, despite fewer program events being offered during the reporting period. Usage of computer workstations is slightly down, but laptop usage is up, even though most of the reporting period saw at least a few laptops out of service for repairs. Starting in 2020, statistics reports will include monthly counts of completed room reservations, which had not previously been reported.

Programs and Events

A wave of holiday and year-end programs took place from early December through the first days of January, all of which were well attended, including a concert by HarpEssence, Santa Storytime, the Merry Grinchmas Party, Stan Lee Celebration Day, Noon Year's Eve and an interactive screening of Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone. The Friends of the Coppell Public Library partnered with a local resident to hold a gift-wrapping drive through the month of December, with the proceeds going to the Friends.
