Reference: Ordinance for No Parking on sections of Ruby Road

General Information:

• This ordinance is presented to establish a no parking area on Ruby Road at the request of several residents.

Introduction:

This agenda item is being presented for approval of an ordinance amending Article 8-3, Parking, Section 8-3-1(A) of the Code of Ordinances to make it unlawful to stop, stand, or park a vehicle, at all times, on the northside of Ruby Road 100 feet east and west of the two private driveways to Oak Park Village mobile home park.

Analysis:

At the request of several residents at the Oak Park Village mobile home park, this ordinance amendment is presented to establish a 100 foot no parking area on both sides of the two private driveways. Vehicles park on both sides of the driveways blocking the visibility of cars pulling out onto Ruby Road.

Legal Review:

The ordinance has been reviewed by the City Attorney.

Fiscal Impact:

The signs will be installed by the Traffic Division, as budgeted under Traffic Control.

Recommendation:

The Public Works Department recommends approval of this ordinance.
