**Reference:** Consider approval of the property tax revenue increase

**2030:** Sustainable City Government

### **Introduction:**

Pursuant to Section 102.007 (c) of the Texas Local Government Code, when a budget raises more revenue from property tax than in the previous year, a separate vote of the governing body is required to ratify this increase. A vote under this section is in addition to and separate from the vote to adopt the budget or a vote to set the tax rate.

### **Analysis:**

This separate agenda item requirement is based on the fact the Fiscal Year 2020-21 Annual Operating Budget will raise more revenue from property taxes than last year's budget.

# **Legal Review:**

This agenda item was reviewed during the Council packet process.

### **Fiscal Impact:**

The property tax revenue increase is \$1,224,170, which is a 2.58% increase from last year's budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$1,770,734.

### **Recommendation:**

The Finance Department recommends approval.
