Reference: Trinity River Authority Contract Update

Introduction:

The purpose of this work session item is to update the Council on the upcoming Trinity River Authority contract.

Background:

The City of Coppel contracts with Trinity River Authority for industrial inspection services, industrial sampling services, and analytical services. This contract enables the city to comply with all applicable state and federal laws, including the Clean Water Act and the General Pretreatment Regulations.

Under this contract, Trinity River Authority performs all industrial user survey activities, notifies industrial users required to complete the Industrial User Survey Form, permits industrial users, and inspects permitted facilities as needed.

Trinity River Authority also performs sampling services and classifies and documents all of the required discharge practices of industrial users.

Analysis:

The contract amount for FY'21-22 is estimated to be \$9,500.00, which is the same dollar amount as FY'20-22. All expenses incurred by the Environmental Health Division for inspections and sampling are charged back to the industry.
