General Information:

• Contract with Dallas County Health and Human Services for mosquito adulticiding and larvaciding.

Introduction:

The City of Coppell Environmental Health Division has an Integrated Mosquito Management Program. If West Nile Virus or any other viruses are detected in mosquito samples or confirmed human cases, adulticiding is necessary and Dallas County will perform ground spraying.

Analysis:

If areas that have tested positive are not treated as quickly as possible, disease can continue to spread, so response time with chemical treatment is an important factor in slowing down disease transmission.
