The Cozby Library and Community Commons Advisory Board met in regular session on Thursday, October 10, 2019, in the conference room of the Library.

Regular Session (Open to the Public)

Call To Order

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Adrienne Morton at 7:50 p.m. Other Board members present were Janet Koester, Madeleine White, Jan Lorrain, Mathew Ittoop and Frank Gasparro. Youth Advisor Aditya Dixit was also present. Staff in attendance were Director Dennis Quinn, Assistant Director Amy Pittman-Hassett and Sr. Administrative Technician Kim McGrath.

Approval of minutes from the September 12th meeting

Janet Koester moved to approve the minutes and Madeleine White seconded the motion. All were in favor and the minutes were approved.

Citizens' Forum

No one signed up to speak.

Director's Report

The Library has seen increases in programs and attendance. Overall circulation statistics are down slightly. There was a tabulation error in recording the stats for eBooks. When corrected, the growth for eBooks was slightly below past numbers but audiobooks have increased significantly. This may be attributed to the growth of our Cloud Link collective.

Study rooms, conference room and business center have been refurbished with paint and chair rails and a new TV mounting system. Corner guards are scheduled for installation. New white boards have been ordered for the conference room and business center.

J.J. White will be moving into the part-time Outreach Librarian position.

Dennis explained the goal of the position. Library is in the process of screening candidates for her vacated full-time librarian position.

The World Languages Survey had 400 responses after eight days. The survey was conducted to assess the needs of the community in regard to establishing a foreign languages collection.

He asked about having another library location in northeastern Coppell. Dennis replied this would probably not be feasible due to the small land area of Coppell. The mobile outreach vehicle was discussed.
